

MEDFORD FIRE DEPARTMENT HIGH RISE PLAN

FIRE ATTACK

Responsibilities

- Assume Command if first on scene
- Size up the situation
- Assign first alarm resources
- Request additional alarms
- Initiate the attack

Information you need

- Pre-plan – Bring it with you

Radio Frequency

- Operate on the primary tactical frequency

Obtain

- Keys necessary to access your floor

Consider

- Gathering information from occupants and staff prior to ascending
- Requesting PD Officers to assist in the lobby area with the occupants
- Checking the alarm panel for fire location information
- Passing Command to 8153
- Providing routine briefings to 8153
- Determining the needs on your attack floor – you may end up reassigned as a Division.
- Evaluating the safety of using elevators

ACTIONS

FIRST CREW ON SCENE

- **Provide initial report**
 - Switch to tactical frequency
- **Take entire crew into Lobby**
 - Bring Bundle, Irons, Flashlights, and Thermal Camera
- **Obtain available information from people in Lobby**
 - Rescue / Fire problem?
- **Provide follow up report:**
 - Fire Situation
 - Request additional alarms
 - Designate the Attack stairwell and Standpipe to be used
 - Assign First alarm crews
 - Additional Fire Attack plus standpipe support
 - Ventilation
 - Lobby
 - Staging
- **Take stairwell to Fire Floor**
- **Captain**
 - Size up fire floor and floors above and below, provide report.
- **Crew**
 - Carry equipment, lay out hose to initiate attack
- **Begin Fire Attack**

SECOND CREW ASSIGNED

- **Engineer pump Standpipe**
- **Crew report to Attack**
 - Bring bundle, irons, flashlight, and TIC
